

# Travel Information

## How to get to Frick, Switzerland

Frick is situated between Basle (EuroAirport) and Zurich (Zurich Airport) close to the border to Germany in the northwestern part of Switzerland.

### From Zurich Airport

**Direct trains from Zurich Airport to Frick:** every hour from 6:04 until 21:04 (ca. 50 minutes)

From the airport there are also many trains to Zurich main station. From there take the train in the direction of Brugg, Baden, **Frick**, Basel.

Trains from Zurich main station to Frick:

From 5:36 until 23:36 every hour **direct** train (ca. 40 minutes)

From 6:06 until 21:06 every hour **change in Brugg** (ca. 50 minutes)

### From Basle EuroAirport

Departure Bus number 50 to Basle SBB in front of the airport. Between 6:00 and 20:00 there is a bus every 7 minutes. 5 minutes walk to the station.

Train to Frick in the direction of Zurich

From 5:14 until 0:14 every hour direct train (ca. 30 minutes)

From 4:40 until 19:40 every hour direct train (ca. 25 minutes)

### To Zurich Airport

**Direct trains from Frick to Zurich Airport:** every hour from 5:04 until 20:04 (ca. 50 minutes)

Trains to Zurich main station: From 5:42 until 23:42 direct train every hour (ca. 40 minutes)

### To Basle EuroAirport

Train to Frick direction of Zurich

From 6:17 until 0:14 every hour direct train (ca. 30 minutes)

From 4:40 until 19:40 every hour direct train (ca. 25 minutes)

3 minutes walk to the bus stop. Bus number 50 to of the airport Basle EuroAirport. Between 6:00 and 20:00 bus every 7 minutes.

### From Zurich or Basel

- Depart Zurich: xx:06 and xx:36  
Arrive in Frick: xx:54 and xx:17
- Depart Basel: xx:14 and xx:42
- Arrive in Frick: xx:41 and xx:03

## From Bern and Olten

- Take the train to Aarau. In Aarau catch the Postauto bus (via Staffeleg) to Frick, alighting at the Frick Unterdorf bus stop.
- A Postauto bus departs every hour from Aarau via Staffeleg. Mornings, lunchtimes and late afternoons there is a more frequent bus service.
- From the Frick Unterdorf bus stop it is a 20-minute walk to FiBL. We are happy to collect you from the station or the Postauto bus stop if you prefer.

Please note that on Sundays and on holidays as well as late in the evenings and early in the mornings the trains may be less frequent than indicated above, so always check the SBB timetable.

## By car

### From Basel or Zurich

- Take motorway A3, leaving at the Frick exit.
- In the village, take the road signposted to Laufenburg. After the motorway underpass, take the second turning on the left: follow the signpost to "Landw. Zentrum" (Agricultural Centre).

### From Bern

- Head for Basel on the motorway. At the Augst motorway interchange, head for Zurich, leaving at the Frick exit.
- In the village, take the road signposted to Laufenburg. After the motorway underpass, take the second turning on the left: follow the signpost to "Landw. Zentrum" (Agricultural Centre).

## By air

### Airport Zürich

There is an hourly direct train Frick/Airport Zürich (ca. 45 minutes). Furthermore there are trains from the airport to Zürich main station and from there to Frick (duration ca. 1 hour).

### Airport Basel/Mulhouse

From the airport Basel/Mulhouse there is a train to Basel main station (Basel SBB) every 15 minutes, duration is ca. 20 minutes. From Basel main station there are two trains per hour to Frick, duration ca. 25 minutes.

### Airport Geneva

From Geneva airport there is a train going into the direction of Frick every 30 minutes. You need to change either in Aarau, Basel, Brugg or Zürich. The journey lasts three to four hours.

Please note that on Sundays and on holidays as well as late in the evenings and early in the mornings the trains may be less frequent than indicated above, so always check the SBB timetable.
